P18 | KARRATHA & NICKOL BAY HELICOPTER FLIGHT

Flight time: 18 minutes | Cost: \$195 per person

Take off over the city of Karratha following the curve of Nickol Bay, featuring the popular swimming spot Hearson's Cove. You will then fly past the thriving transport hub of the Pilbara iron ore and LNG industries. See the ammonia plant and the many salt lakes that are an impressive sight from the air. Following the coastline you may even see glimpses of marine life that reside in the bays and ocean channels!

P30 | BURRUP PENINSULA & ANGEL ISLAND HELICOPTER FLIGHT

Flight time: 30 minutes | Cost: \$325 per person

On departure, orbit the city of Karratha before heading up the coast of the Burrup Peninsula. Fly past Hearson's Cove and onwards toward Sea Ripple Passage. View the picturesque islands of the Dampier Peninsula, including Angel Island and Dolphin Island. The Burrup Peninsula is home to some of the oldest and most plentiful Aboriginal rock art in Australia. Marine life abounds all the way, with manta rays, turtles, dugongs and more. Flying down the western side of the Peninsula you will see the LNG and iron ore industries in full swing and then the main salt lakes before heading back to Karratha.

P45 | DAMPIER ARCHIPELAGO ISLANDS HELICOPTER FLIGHT

Flight time: 45 minutes | Cost: \$495 per person

Fly over a chain of 42 islands in the Dampier Archipelago with picturesque sandy white beaches, set amongst the raw beauty of the rugged Pilbara landscape. It is not uncommon to witness an abundance of coastal wildlife such as turtles, manta rays, dugongs, dolphins, schools of fish, birdlife... you may even see a whale or two! Fly over the clear blue ocean to the pristine white sand beaches on the many islands west of the Burrup Peninsula. These islands are a haven for the locals and it is clear to see why! Many marine species choose to make their nests here, including turtles and a range of bird life. The port of Dampier greets you as you make landfall again, where the ships of the iron ore and LNG industries are filled by the many trains connecting Karratha to the heart of the Pilbara.

Maximum seat limit 136kg, R44 helicopter.

Cameras and phones must have lanyards/wrist straps. iPads and tablets are not permitted on board.

Cancellation Policy

Day Flights/Tours: Within 24 hours or less of departure: NON-REFUNDABLE.

24 hours to 7 days prior to departure: 20% administration fee will be charged per booking.

Overnight Tour Packages: Within 7 days or less of departure: NON-REFUNDABLE.

8 days to 14 days prior to departure: 50% of booking will be retained.

15 days to 30 days prior to departure: 20% of booking will be retained.

Cancellations must be advised in writing.

A minimum of two passengers or the equivalent cost is required to confirm a flight.

Child Age/Infant Policy

Infants are classified as 0-2 years, and may travel free of charge, on their parent's lap. Please note that only one infant may travel per aircraft. Children classified as 3-12 years of age inclusive, must be accompanied by an adult on the flight.

Passengers must be at the aircraft departure point 30 minutes prior to scheduled departure time.
