
ABOUT THE AREA

Western Australia's Kimberley Region is in the far north of the state and indigenous people have inhabited its enormous and rugged country for over 50,000 years. The climate is monsoonal and defines the landscape, which is astonishingly beautiful. The Kimberley covers an expanse of nearly 423,000 square kilometres (three times the size of England) with a population of only 33,000 people. A few hundred kilometres over the border in the Northern Territory is Katherine Gorge or Nitmiluk. Views from the air are spectacular and helicopters are the perfect aerial platform to capture close up views of the landscape. On some flights we land and shut the helicopter down to fish in wild rivers or swim in secret springs.

BUNGLE BUNGLE HELICOPTER FLIGHTS FROM WARMUN

Warmun is 200km south of Kununurra and 160km north of Halls Creek and is the closest settlement to the Bungle Bungle Range in Purnululu National Park. HeliSpirit helicopter flights depart from our helipad near the roadhouse, which has a shady caravan park and accommodation. Choose from a 45 minute scenic flight, the flight with a ground tour of the Bungle Bungle or include an overnight stay. We provide free secure storage for your vehicle and caravan.





B45 | BUNGLE BUNGLE HELICOPTER FLIGHT

As we take off from Warmun, we are but a minute away from the Osmand Range, in Purnululu Conservation Area, quite spectacular in its own right as it abuts the World Heritage Listed Purnululu National Park. The Osmand Range is one of the Kimberley's lesserknown spectacular ranges, filled with Livistona palms clinging to gorges and endless waves of ancient rocks rolling towards the east. Over the Bungle Bungle, this flight takes in the Red Rock Gorges of the Northern Massif, the Western Wall, Horseshoe Valley, Piccaninny Gorge and Creek with its ancient banded sandstone domes, Deep Gorge and Y Gorge. B45BB4 | PICCANINNY GORGE HELI-HIKE

Take a spectacular scenic helicopter flight over the Osmand Range and the Bungle Bungle, landing in Purnululu National Park. Collect your guide and fly on to land near the mouth of Piccaninny Gorge. A 10km return hike takes you through the creek bed between the towering walls of the otherwise inaccessible gorge. Return by helicopter with stunning views of the sunset on the ranges. All water and food must be carried. There is no marked path as this is a walk not accessible other than on this tour or on a 3-day hike. Spectacularly magnificent, this adventure is for experienced hikers with a high level of fitness required. Flight time: 40 minutes and 28 minutes

BUNGLE BUNGLE HELICOPTER FLIGHTS FROM PURNULULU NATIONAL PARK

HeliSpirit helicopter flights departing from inside the National Park give the full flight time over the Bungle Bungle. HeliSpirit flights offer the best value for money. Our office and helipad are at Bellburn Airstrip in Purnululu National Park. We are the original helicopter flight operator with multi-award wins for our pioneering scenic flights.

A18 | BUNGLE BUNGLE DOMES SPECIAL

Depart Bellburn Airstrip for the southern tip of the Bungle Bungle Range where you will view Y Gorge before flying across the top of the massif to the mouth of spectacular Piccaninny Gorge. Soar over Piccaninny Creek to view and photograph Cathedral Gorge and the famous black and orange striped beehive shaped domes.

Flight time: 18 minutes | Cost: \$289 per person

A30 | THE ORIGINAL HELICOPTER FLIGHT OVER THE BUNGLE BUNGLE

The sandstone massif of the Bungle Bungle Range is almost 99 times the area of Uluru – there are more stunning features and spectacular landforms to see in this half hour scenic flight than you would imagine possible. View the hidden red rock gorges of the north west tip, Piccaninny Gorge from end to end and the unique beehive formations that have contributed to the listing of Purnululu National Park as one of Australia's World Heritage areas.

Flight time: 30 minutes | Cost: \$399 per person

A42 | BUNGLE BUNGLE LONG LOOK

Depart Bellburn Airstrip for the southern tip of the Bungle Bungle Range to view Deep Gorge and 'The Twins'. Continue on to the highest point of the Bungle Bungle and the spectacular Red Rock Gorges of the north-west. View the eastern side of the range, to encounter incredible eroded sandstone formations and a maze of gorges, soaring over the Valley of the Giants with its massive sandstone structures. Fly along the southern face to the mouth of Piccaninny Gorge, follow Piccaninny Creek to view and photograph Cathedral Gorge and the famous orange and black striped beehive shaped domes. Flight time: 42 minutes | Cost: \$499 per person

A18BB4 | PICCANINNY GORGE HELI-HIKE

Fly over the Bungle Bungle on the Domes Special flight (A18) and land near the mouth of Piccaninny Gorge. This enormous gorge spreads into five fingers as it cuts through the Bungle Bungle Range. Your guide will lead the hike into the gorge and tell you about the area's significance to the Aboriginal people and it's unique history, which led to the world heritage listing of Purnululu. The hike is up to 10km return and requires a high level of fitness and mobility. The rocky creek bed of Piccaninny Gorge is classed as a level 5 walk. Picnic lunch, morning/afternoon tea and cold water is included. Departs: Bellburn Airstrip early morning | Flight time: 12 minutes and 6 minutes Tour duration: 8 hours | Cost: \$799 per person

The World Heritage listed Purnululu National Park is the first National Park in the Kimberley to be jointly managed by the Aboriginal Traditional owners and the Department of Parks and Wildlife (DPAW). The system of joint management acknowledges the Aboriginal people's traditional responsibility for care of the country and the well-being of visitors. BUNGLE BUNGLE HELICOPTER ADVENTURES FROM KUNUNURRA

From Kununurra to the Bungle Bungle, this epic adventure is truly the Flight of A Lifetime, as it includes the Kimberley's most well known features. Showcasing National Parks, cattle stations, the Ord Irrigation Area, Osmand Range, Ragged Range, Argyle Diamond Mine and Lake Argyle. Soar through ranges and gorges and follow waterholes spotting wildlife. Our experienced pilots will show you exciting views of the ancient Bungle Bungle Range in Purnululu National Park, viewing the entire massif with its beehive shaped sandstone domes, gorges and rifts. KHBB | BUNGLE BUNGLE HELICOPTER AND SECRET SPRINGS PICNIC

Departs: Kununurra

Flight time: 3 hours | Tour duration: 5 hours | Cost: \$1999 per person This scenic air tour includes a stunning scenic flight with the features listed above, a landing at the airstrip in the Bungle Bungle for refreshments and at a secret spring in the ranges enroute to picnic and swim. A good level of mobility is required for the short hike to the waterhole. Available year round with spectacular waterfalls after the rains in February and March. Bring your swimming apparel and wear walking shoes that can get wet.

KHBBG | BUNGLE BUNGLE HELICOPTER AND PRIVATE CATHEDRAL GORGE WALK TOUR

Departs: Kununurra at 6am

Flight time: 3 hours | Tour duration: 8 hours | Cost: Adult \$2299 Child \$2249

This option includes a private guided walking tour at the Bungle Bungle. From April to November we land at Bellburn airstrip where your 4WD/ walking tour begins. From December to March, when the National Park is closed, we land at the Cathedral Gorge car park to start the guided walk. Be one of only a handful of people who have entered Purnululu in the waterfall season between December and April. In the waterfall season, bring your swimming apparel, wear walking shoes that can get wet. A change of clothing is advised for the return flight.

KHBBGO | BUNGLE BUNGLE HELICOPTER, PRIVATE CATHEDRAL GORGE, DOMES AND ECHIDNA CHASM WALK TOUR. OVERNIGHT

Day 1 departs: Kununurra at 6am | Day 2 departs: Purnululu at 7.30am Flight time: 3 hours | Tour duration: Full day and overnight | Cost: \$2499 pp

This option includes two guided ground tours at the Bungle Bungle. The morning tour is of the banded sandstone domes, Cathedral Gorge area and the afternoon tour is of the Western Wall and Echidna Chasm. Overnight in a deluxe ensuite cabin at the Bungle Bungle Savannah Lodge. All meals included. Please ensure you have breakfast before departing on day one. Available April to October.



HELICOPTER FLIGHTS FROM MITCHELL FALLS CAMPGROUND

HeliSpirit's Mitchell Falls helicopter flights give you a magnificent bird's eye view of this remote wilderness. The walk to the Mitchell Falls from the campground is 4.5 km one way and can take from 1.5 to 3 hours. The walk passes little Mertens Falls, galleries of ancient rock art sites and Monsoon vine thickets. The Mitchell Falls helicopter flight can transfer you from the helipad at the top of the Mitchell Falls back to the campground, or fly you in and drop you off. Flights depart from the campground or from the top of the Mitchell Falls. Bookings are essential and need to be made prior to walking into the falls.

MF6 | MITCHELL FALLS HELICOPTER TRANSFER

Take a "Falls Transfer" flight from the campground to the Mitchell Falls, land and walk back to camp or walk into the falls and catch a "Falls Transfer" flight back to the campground. Both flights include a short scenic over the Mitchell Falls and Mertens Gorge.

Flight time: 6 minutes (one way) Cost: \$145 per person

MF18 | MITCHELL PLATEAU TRIPLE WATERFALLS

Fly downstream via the Mitchell River to the Lower Mitchell Falls where the freshwater meets the saltwater. Orbit the falls and fly back to the Mitchell Falls via the western gorge where you will orbit JCR Falls. This flight can transfer you from the falls to the campground or vice versa.

MF48 | THE PLATEAU COASTAL HELICOPTER EXPERIENCE


Fly over the Mitchell Plateau to the waters of Admiralty Gulf. Follow the coast from Walsh Point to Crystal Head, looking for marine life, then across to Crystal Creek following the edge of the Plateau and over to Walmsley Bay. Soar upstream, following the Mitchell River to the Lower Mitchell Falls, the majestic 3-tiered Mitchell Falls and Mertens Gorge. This flight can transfer you from the falls to the campground or vice versa.

Flight time: 48 minutes

Cost: \$499 pp (4 people) | \$599 pp (3 people) | \$859 pp (2 people)










HELICOPTER FLIGHTS FROM KUNUNURRA

Kununurra was established in 1960 as the centre for the Ord River Irrigation project. Situated on the edge of Lake Kununurra, the views are spectacular, with the Carr Boyd Range bordering the Ord Valley to the south and the thousands of acres of irrigated farmland stretching north.





KH18 | KUNUNURRA SNAPSHOT

Discover tropical Kununurra from an eagle's view with a thrilling helicopter flight over the Ord River, part of the Ord Valley Irrigation Area and Mirima National Park. Flight time: 18 minutes | Cost: \$199 per person

KH30 | ORD RIVER VALLEY HELICOPTER FLIGHT






EL QUESTRO HELICOPTER ADVENTURES

Land on top of the amazing Cockburn Range, fly through Pentecost Gorge and beyond. View waterfalls and caves only accessible by helicopter. An El Questro helicopter flight is a truly indescribable experience we strongly recommend to everyone. Scenic helicopter flights depart regularly from the Station helipad.





EL1 | AMAROO FALLS HELICOPTER ADVENTURE

Only accessible by helicopter this amazing wonderland has 15 cascading waterfalls ranging from knee-high falls to falls of 45m in height, several pristine swimming holes and some of the most breathtaking views El Questro has. Picnic included. Flight time: 30 minutes | Tour duration: 3 hours | Cost: \$699 per person

EL2 | MIRI MIRI FALLS BY HELICOPTER

Hidden in a remote corner of El Questro is Miri Miri Falls. 

KING GEORGE FALLS HELICOPTER ADVENTURE

KHKG | KING GEORGE FALLS, BERKELEY RIVER AND CAMBRIDGE GULF HELICOPTER ADVENTURE

Northwest of Kununura lies a remote, untouched coastline bordering the Timor Sea. The Cambridge Gulf carries water from five huge rivers northwards to the coast and further north, the Berkeley and King George rivers carve their way through red rugged gorges on their way to the ocean.
